the bird was loth to fly

1940 - Bird circled the esplanade and landed

Lesser Scaup Duck.

Dec 1/29 - Jos. Ewan saw small group
flying across lower campus toward the
Bell air pond across Beverly Blvd.
He watched them on the pond for short
time so that identity is pretty certain.

Osprey

1935 - June 18 Bird perched on East corner of
Chem. Bldg. teased by Sparrow Hawks.

1943 - Sept 15. Seen by Ray Cowles + class. beating about over
Sivarium + Life Sci Bldg. harried by Brewer Blk. bid.

Prarie Falcon

Falco mexicanus

At the ceremony dedicating the campus Oct 25, 1926, one of these birds flew over the ^{n. w.} ^{s. e.} graded stand so that its shadow attracted the attention of both Alden and myself.

Jan 26. 1931 - a specimen flew across at lower level than Royce towers, passed west of Chem Bldg and north east - across head of ravine close to ground. Seen from my north window.
